

MY OWN CHURCH

St. Mark's has been using a web-based suite of applications for several years now to track the parish finances and contributions as well as member demographic data. One of the features of this set of applications is the ability for individuals and their families to access their personal contributions and demographic information and to provide updates and download their own contribution statements called

My Own Church. Here is how to create or access your account:

The URL is https://oca.parishsoftfamilysuite.com/

- 1. Then click on the New User link highlighted below and follow the directions to request access. Fill in all of the fields marked with a red *and then click Submit.
- 2.Once you submit your request, and if all of the information you supplied matches what is in the system, you will be sent an email with a temporary password which you should change after you login for the first time.
- 3. If the system cannot match your data, the system administrator will be notified to review the information and approve your account.


